Hello Eastern Greene Families,

With Covid cases increasing across the state, I wanted to make sure everyone was reminded of the hybrid schedule. If our county is “orange” or “red” we may put the hybrid schedule into action. Each Wednesday, at noon, the Indiana State Department of Health releases information indicating the county “color”. This color signifies the amount of new Covid cases and the rate of spread. Orange and Red signifies that there are a significant number of new cases and the rate of spread has increased. The suggestion from the state and Greene County is that schools go to a hybrid learning schedule when the county is orange or red. Here is what Eastern Greene School’s hybrid model will look like:

1. We will find out our county color on noon each Wednesday. Staff, students, and parents will be notified on Wednesday if we will go to a hybrid schedule.
2. All schools will meet in person on Thursday of that week.
3. On Friday of that week, and Tuesday of the following week, students with last names starting with A-M will attend in person at the Middle School and High School. This will be known as a “Red Day”.
4. On Monday and Wednesday of the following week, students with last names starting with N-Z will attend school in person at the Middle School and High School. This will be known as a “Black Day”.
5. When not attending school in person, students will have work to complete at home.
6. The hybrid schedule does not affect the elementary school. Students will continue to meet in person during the hybrid schedule.
7. If we are “orange” athletic practices and events will still take place.
8. If we are “red”, we may only allow Varsity and JV practices and events to take place. Of course, there will also be reductions in the amount of spectators allowed at events when we are “yellow”, “orange”, or “red”.
9. Reminders and announcements will be sent out prior to enacting this schedule.
